Staff at start and end of line. Reflective jackets to be worn if poor visibility.</li> <li>• Personal clothing, food and drink to be correct for conditions and duration of visit.</li> <li>• Equipment to be kept in good state of repair.</li> <li>• Mobile phone to be carried by instructors for emergency use.</li> <li>• Office staff at Braeside to be instructed of groups location</li> <li>• Continuous assessment of weather conditions</li> <li>• Beware of dogs and manage group accordingly</li> <li>• Maintain tight group management along Drews Pond Lane, as it is a driveway.</li> </ul>
