<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact with animals and their waste • Contact with hazardous materials and chemicals • Contact with machinery and tools • Slippery surfaces and muddy footpaths • Contact with weeds and crops (stinging nettles) • Barbed wire and electric fences • Cold/hot weather conditions • Private buildings – poorly maintained • Hazards increased by poor behaviour, poor fencing and signage • Allergies to livestock, milk, grains • Road crossings – moving traffic • Tractor rides 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students • Volunteers • Visiting staff • Braeside staff • Farm staff 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High ratio adult and children • Fore warning of conditions and appropriate clothing (telephone farm prior to visit) • Clear briefing of rules / expectations • Clear liaison between Braeside, farm and school staff • Stay safe distance (behind rails) from goats and other animals • Wash hands after handling animals or crops, and again back at Braeside • Warning of not to eat anything on site • When sitting in the tractor, not to be started or moved • Only access buildings specifically taken to by farm workers • Check medical allergies / conditions of group before visiting • Group to be managed in each area of the farm and given clear instructions/reminders • Supervised road crossing as one group. • Request Mr J Butlers RA for tractor ride. All to be seated, high sides and rails on trailer and on steps. Descend and ascend using steps, slow speeds by experienced driver. • See additional RA's for Rowdefield Farm – ask Braeside for details/copies
