Carry, and use, high visibility vests. • Clear notification to group of obstacles, holes, livestock on path. • Check shooting dates and avoid use on relevant days. • Check access with land owner prior to visit. • If foraging safety guidance is followed and only forageables are collected that have been CHECKED by the Braeside staff member.
