4	Falling in water/drowning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants</li> <li>• Braeside Staff</li> <li>• Visiting Staff</li> </ul>	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pupils to stay at least one meter away from the edge of the water whenever possible. Including walking on tow paths, looking at locks, waiting to dip.</li> <li>• Verbal brief to be given about walking on tow paths before setting off from Braeside.</li> <li>• Clear verbal warnings and instructions given, including footing and stability at water's edge</li> <li>• Leader to carry throw line, demonstrate use to new staff / users</li> </ul>	Low
5	Waterborne illness (e.g. weils disease)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants</li> <li>• Braeside Staff</li> <li>• Visiting Staff</li> </ul>	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cover open cuts and don't get wet</li> <li>• Verbal warning to keep hands away from mouth and to wash hands as soon as possible.</li> <li>• No food to be consumed without hand cleaning</li> </ul>	Low
6	Contact with public, dogs, swans, and dog faeces	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants</li> <li>• Braeside Staff</li> <li>• Visiting Staff</li> </ul>	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Group to be always supervised by leader</li> <li>• Make sure minimal amount of space is taken up.</li> <li>• Area to be check and group to be warned about faeces</li> <li>• If dogs are present ask participants to leave them alone</li> <li>• Politely ask dog owner to put dogs on lead if cause nuisance</li> </ul>	Low
7	Cars in car park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants</li> <li>• Braeside Staff</li> <li>• Visiting Staff</li> </ul>	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adult supervision during photosearch, clear instructions on boundaries for activity</li> <li>• Verbal Brief that there still may be cars moving around in area.</li> </ul>	Medium
	Hazards increased by poor weather	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants</li> <li>• Braeside Staff</li> <li>• Visiting Staff</li> </ul>	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clear verbal warnings and instructions given, including footing and stability at waters edge</li> <li>• Carry first aid kit</li> </ul>	Medium

	Passing boats	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants</li> <li>• Braeside Staff</li> <li>• Visiting Staff</li> </ul>	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If boats are close to fishing platforms, ask participant to stand back from edge till boat passes</li> </ul>	Low
	Trips and falls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants</li> <li>• Braeside Staff</li> <li>• Visiting Staff</li> </ul>	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clear verbal warnings and instructions given, including footing and stability at waters edge</li> <li>• Carry first aid kit</li> </ul>	low
	inexperienced adults supervising	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants</li> </ul>	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supervisors of activity to be briefed by Braeside staff Prior to leading activity</li> <li>• Risk assessment and operation procedure to be given to supervising staff for reading before session.</li> </ul>	Low
