Staff at start and end of line. Reflective jackets to be worn if poor visibility. • Personal clothing, food and drink to be correct for conditions and duration of visit. • Equipment to be kept in good state of repair. • Mobile phone to be carried by instructors for emergency use. • Office staff at Braeside to be instructed of groups location • Continuous assessment of weather conditions • Beware of dogs and manage group accordingly • Maintain tight group management along Drews Pond Lane, as it is a driveway.
