<p>Ball games:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tripping • Collisions – objects, other children • Hit by ball <p>Volleyball:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tripping on guy lines • Hit by ball • Guy Pegs • Net collapsing <p>Table Tennis:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying bats & balls • Splinters <p>Table football</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trapped fingers • Hit by handles or raquet <p>Slipping Bumping into each other Falling off patio to lawn Splinters Hazards increased by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equipment condition • Wet weather • Poor behaviour 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Centre users (students, staff and others) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thorough briefing to include out of bounds areas and equipment not to be used (i.e. rocking platform, ropes course etc) BEFORE group have access to grounds • Behaviour expectations, • Advise skittle ball danger, observe from safe distance • Advise to stop activities if very wet lawn or waterlogged • Location of adults and first aid kit • Visiting staff to be briefed to supervise group and any specific students who require specific attention • Regular check of condition of equipment and ball court • Warning of patio edge/steps and to not run around patio area
