1	Falling (up to 12m off ground)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Braeside Staff</li> <li>Bystanders</li> </ul>	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At least 2 persons involved in high level working, one may be on the ground.</li> <li>Instructor to always be connected by at least two attachments unless carrying out a climb which any participant would be expected to do.</li> <li>Attachment points to be above head if possible.</li> </ul>			Low
2	Falling items (equipment) Items falling from the person	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Braeside Staff</li> <li>Bystanders</li> </ul>	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Keep people away from area underneath and no loose items on person – empty pockets before climbing.</li> <li>All Tools and equipment to be always attached to person</li> <li>All items being lowered must be lower by a suitable method not by hand.</li> </ul>			Low
3	Impact against hard pole and platform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Braeside Staff</li> </ul>	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Instructor to always be connected by at least two attachments point, one of which should be kept tight</li> <li>Attachment points to be above head if possible.</li> <li>Helmets to be always worn when working at height</li> </ul>			Low

4	Becoming stuck	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Braeside Staff</li></ul>	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Working at hight only to be undertaking by a suitable qualified/trained member of staff.</li><li>Secoded member of staff to be aware of what to do if this happens</li><li>Clear communication to be kept between ground and climbing.</li></ul>	Low
5	Splinter or cuts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Braeside Staff</li></ul>	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Gloves available to be worn</li><li>First aid kit to be taken down</li></ul>	Low
